

Footnotes

Footnotes are referenced in a paragraph¹ and then written on a line that starts with two points, the footnote mark and their text.

Footnote references can also be autonumbered², or autonumbered with a label³, for ease of referencing.

It is also possible to reference a footnote using a set^{*} of automatically[†] chosen symbols.

Footnotes inside other footnotes?⁴

In this example, spaces before the footnote reference are suppressed by the renderer. The PDF version moves the notes in their traditional position at the bottom of the page, while the HTML one keeps them where they were written in the source.
